The forthcoming Kendall PhiloMusica Concert on Sunday July 22 at 2 pm welcomes back the brilliant Russian guitar virtuoso Vladimir Gorbach to the Kendall School of Arts. The Russian virtuoso will perform solo works by Scarlatti, Ginastera, Llobet and Aguado as well as Schubert's Sonata in A major (with violinist Goetz Richter). Vladimir Gorbach is an internationally acclaimed recitalist and recording artist who has widely performed in Europe, Asia and the Americas. He is currently a lecturer at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. His first appearance for the Kendall PhiloMusica series in 2016 was received with enthusiastic acclaim.

The Kendall PhiloMusica series explores the relationship between philosophy and music. The performance on July 22 at 2 pm will be introduced with philosophical reflections on listening and the role of the audience by the founder and director of the PhiloMusica series, musician and philosopher Goetz Richter.
